**Coral Gables, FL**, July 14, 2003 - Sixties folk/rock greats, The Lovin' Spoonful, will headline the next Nostalgia Concert presented by The Biltmore Hotel's Cellar Club, Sunday, August 31, 2003 at 9:00 p.m. The concert will benefit the University of Miami Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center and is sponsored by Southern Wine & Spirits.
